**Issues in the Socio-Affective Development
of Gifted and Talented Students**

at the Kensington Campus of UNSW, Sydney

Cost: \$600 for the three days

GERRIC is delighted to present the fifth in a new series of Master Classes in aspects of gifted education featuring national and international leaders in the field.

Applicants should be qualified teachers with significant classroom experience and should have already attended a university-developed course in gifted education which has included a substantial component on social-emotional development: for example, an MEd subject specifically on social-emotional development of gifted students or a postgraduate certificate or diploma specifically in gifted education. The course has been designed for teachers, gifted education coordinators, school counsellors and other education professionals with a special interest in the socio-affective development of gifted children or adolescents.

This course will look in depth at issues in the social and emotional development of gifted and talented students. We will discuss how these students' affective differences from their age-peers impact both learning and socialisation. The work of Hollingworth, Dabrowski (including 'overexcitabilities' and positive disintegration) and Silverman will be explored in depth. The impact on family relationships of having a gifted child, enabling and disabling perfectionism, understanding introversion, the 'social coping' strategies used by gifted students and the special concerns of gifted girls and boys will also be explored.
