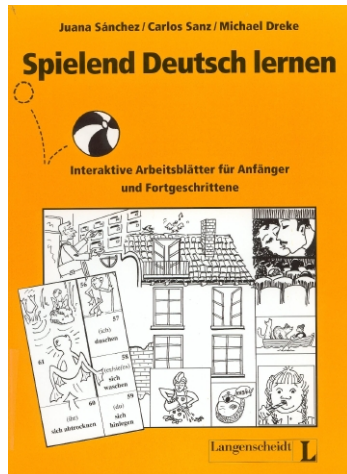


## **Spielend Deutsch lernen** **Interaktive Arbeitsblätter für Anfänger und Fortgeschrittene**

*Spielend Deutsch lernen* is a collection of 30 communicative activities for beginner and intermediate learners of German.

The book is divided into two sections. In the first section, teachers are given a clear overview of the activities, the language objectives, required grammar and vocabulary, as well as level and duration of each activity. The second section has all the photocopiable materials needed for each activity so that they can be quickly and easily incorporated into lessons.

Students have the opportunity to communicate with one another using authentic German in simulated contexts with the emphasis being on enjoyment and fun. There are various games from the classical Memory or *Quartett* to games which require the players to provide real information about such topics as the weather, personal biographies, professions, shopping, in addition to role-plays and problem-solving activities.

The book is aimed at junior secondary students, but provides lots of ideas and materials which can be modified for use with learners of German from K – 12.

**Highly recommended for junior and senior secondary.**
